Our Flowers, Our Ethos, Our Style

We want to create the most amazing, gorgeous, scented flowers for your wedding, and we want to do that using British grown seasonal ingredients, with sustainable mechanics.

This means that all the flowers used are usually grown by me or by other local growers who are all growing flowers with great care for the environment. It also means we don't use plastics such as floral foam to create our designs- we have to come up with other ways to do this without compromising the design of the arrangements.

Ultimately this leads to very natural arrangements with a garden gathered style incorporating lots of movement, texture and interest.

The Pick and Mix Wedding Service

available from the 1st April– 30th September

outside these times we still provide wedding flowers, but the selection is reduced so please do get in touch

The pick and mix wedding allows you to pick the arrangements you require, a colour palette and general theme.

I'll put all your arrangements together and they can be collected from my studio the afternoon/evening before the wedding.

Buckets of flowers can be collected in the morning or the day before to give you time to decorate your venue.

The benefit of this service is that the cost is reduced and the process is straightforward, you'll have beautiful flowers for your wedding with very little fuss.

This service doesn't include the use or hire of any of my containers or structures, face to face consultation or site visit to your venue.

The prices are for the arrangements only and must be collected.

The Wedding Party Flowers

The Bride and Bridesmaids

- Wedding bouquet – usually a forward-facing style slightly wider than deeper - £90
- Bridesmaid bouquet – usually a hand tied style to complement the bride's bouquet - £55
- Flower girl posy – a small hand tied posy - £30
- Willow wand decorated with flowers and ribbon - from £12

Flowers for the hair

- Flower crown - £65
- Flower garland - £40
- Flower comb - £17.50 / £25
- Wired flowers - £1.50 each



The Wedding Party Flowers

- Grooms buttonhole - £10
- Buttonholes - £9
- Corsages (pin) - £12
- Wrist corsage (ribbon) - £20

Confetti

- Dried confetti - £10 per litre

This is usually enough for 10-12 handfuls, and is supplied in paper bags, we don't supply cones etc.





The Venue Flowers

- The simple jam jar - £30
- Windowsill or table arrangements (60-70cms) - £100

This is a long low arrangement – front facing – that is suitable for a table, such as signing the register or a church windowsill. This is easily repurposed at the venue on either the top table or a mantelpiece.

- Buckets of flowers curated to your colour scheme containing a mix of foliage, focal and filler flowers for you to decorate your venue. - £100
